#### **Travel Dates**

Departing Newark, NJ on Sunday, May 26, 2019 bound for Manchester, UK we will spend **10** days touring these fabulous gardens, returning to Newark, NJ on Thursday, June 6, 2019.

#### **Itinerary**

#### **Activity Level/Expectations**

Participants should be in good health and can expect full days of touring which will include a lot of walking throughout the gardens and sites visited, as well as standing and walking for at least one hour of time during garden and or house tours. Tour members will experience walking on various types of terrain not limited to: grass, gravel, woodland paths, hills, slopes, stairs and uneven surfaces. All garden/site visits and tours will take place rain or shine. Please note, we cannot guarantee that all hotels will have elevators so walking up/down flights of stairs may be required.

## Pricing

**\$5,025** per person double-occupancy **based on 22-26 travelers**

**\$4,750** per person double occupancy **based on 27-28 travelers**

**Single Supplement - \$715** Please note: single accommodations are limited.

The trip will take place with a minimum of 22 registered travelers at \$5,025 per person double-occupancy. If registration reaches 27 travelers, the price will drop to \$4,750 per person double-occupancy. The trip will be limited to 28 travelers.

If Brexit occurs prior to departure there is a possibility of additional fees, taxes or charges.

Price includes:

- The land tour, hotels for 10 nights, 10 full breakfasts, 2 group lunches, 10 group dinners, all garden and museum admissions and guided tours.
- Economy round-trip airfare between Newark, NJ and Manchester, England
- Travel Protection Plan (trip insurance)

## Upgrading Group Air Seats

Once group air is ticketed, you will be able to contact United directly to upgrade your seat to Economy Plus if you wish. You will pay the cost directly to United. We will advise when you can upgrade. Please Note: this is the only upgrade allowed with Group Air. If you wish to upgrade to business class, first class, or use frequent flyer miles, you must make your own flight reservations. If you choose Group Air and then wish to change to making your own flight arrangements, there will be a fee to leave the group.

## Making Your Own Flight Reservations

If you wish to make your own flight arrangements, **DO NOT DO SO UNTIL WE ADVISE YOU THAT THE TRIP IS FULL AND THAT THE GROUP AIR IS OFFICIALLY BOOKED.** If you chose to make your own flight reservations, the air portion of your trip will not be covered by the travel insurance we have purchased for the group. You will have to purchase your own insurance to cover your flight. If you change your mind after registration and want to join the group air reservation, group seats may no longer be available and if they are, a change fee will be incurred. Please let us know on the attached registration form if you will be making your own flight reservations. It will be your responsibility to meet the group at the airport in Manchester to begin the tour.

## Cancellation/Itinerary Changes

We reserve the right to cancel the trip if necessary. We also reserve the right to change the itinerary/hotels and make substitutions as may be necessary.
